

ASID TEXAS CHAPTER STUDENT SCHOLARSHIPS – 2010/2011 ACADEMIC YEAR CRITERIA



The ASID Texas Chapter Student Scholarships are intended to encourage professional development in the field of Interior Design by providing scholarships to Texas Chapter ASID Student Members who are declared Interior Design Majors and are enrolled in a CIDA accredited Interior Design program. Each year the ASID Texas Chapter Board will approve the number of awards and financial amounts awarded based on its financial ability. Depending on the number of applicants, the following amounts may be awarded:

- \$2,000
- \$1,500
- \$1,000

ELIGIBILITY

- Application is open to ASID Student Members who are enrolled in the 2010/2011 academic year in one of the CIDA-accredited Interior Design programs within the umbrella of the ASID Texas Chapter: Abilene Christian University, The Art Institute of Dallas, Baylor University, Texas Christian University, Texas State University, Texas Tech University, University of North Texas, The University of Texas at Arlington, The University of Texas at Austin, The University of Texas at San Antonio, and University of the Incarnate Word.
- The applicant must demonstrate a B average (3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale) or better in all major requirements of his/her interior design program courses.
- Once the applicant has received an ASID Texas Chapter Scholarship award, he/she is eligible to reapply for scholarship aid for up to one additional academic year in which he/she remains a student in one of the CIDA accredited Interior Design programs.
- Renewal of an ASID Texas Chapter Scholarship Award will be subject to the applicant maintaining a B average (3.0 GPA) or above during the previous academic year and resubmitting all application materials. Renewal is not assured, however.
- All awards are made without regard to race, creed, color, sex, religion or national origin.

SELECTION

- The ASID Texas Chapter Scholarship Committee reviews all scholarship materials and selects the annual scholarship recipient(s).
- Preference is given to students who have demonstrated outstanding design potential.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

- **All application materials for the 2010/2011 academic year must be postmarked on or before Friday, October 1, 2010.**

- OCTOBER 1, 2010: Postmarked deadline for the receipt of Scholarship Based on Merit Application and Applicant Recommendation Forms, and Personal Statement.
- OCTOBER 11, 2010: Scholarship Winner(s) will be notified by the chapter and their ASID Student Faculty Advisor will also be notified. *Please do not call ASID Texas Chapter for notification.*
